A Short description in easy language:

The performance will be in a black box and performers will engage in dialog with each other and the audience. They will dance, use props and play drums. The music is drums and there will be both low intensity and high intensity parts of the performance. There will be a stretch of black out nearing the end of the performance.

Trigger warnings: Black out for a longer period, and performers addressing the audience. Smoke might occur, lights is being improvised.
